State and Territory Boards of Studies

ACT Board of Senior Secondary Studies (ACTBSSS)

ACT Board of Senior Secondary Studies (ACTBSSS) is a statutory authority responsible for the certification of senior secondary school studies in government and non-government schools in the Australian Capital Territory.

Board of Studies NSW

The Board of Studies NSW was established in 1990 to serve government and non-government schools in the development of school education for Years K-12.

Northern Territory Board of Studies

The Northern Territory Board of Studies develops and provides curriculum, assessment, reporting and certification to students in the Northern Territory from Preschool to Year 12.

Oueensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority (OCAA)

The Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority (QCAA) is a statutory body of the Queensland Government. It was established on 1 July 2014, replacing the Queensland Studies Authority (QSA). The QCAA plays a critical role in the design and delivery of education in Queensland in collaboration with a range of stakeholders and partner agencies.

SACE Board of South Australia

The SACE Board of South Australia serves Year 11 and Year 12 students in all schools and administers the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE).
