## State and Territory Boards of Studies

### [ACT Board of Senior Secondary Studies \(ACTBSSS\)](#)

ACT Board of Senior Secondary Studies (ACTBSSS) is a statutory authority responsible for the certification of senior secondary school studies in government and non-government schools in the Australian Capital Territory.
