# Middle School Bibliography

Students in middle school years should be learning to use the APA 7 system to write their bibliography. They do not need to reference page numbers of books (although this is part of full referencing for senior years students). If there is no date for the source you are using, put (n.d.) meaning no date in replacement of where the year of publication goes.

'A' grade students should be working towards using in-text referencing in addition to their bibliography and are encouraged to utilise referencing software to manage their referencing.

An APA 7 Bibliography should follow the following formats:

### **Book with Author**

Author's family name, Initial/s. (Year of publication). *Title of book (edition if it is not the first)*. Publisher.

## **Book with Corporate Author (company/organisation/government department)**

Authoring body. (Year of publication). *Title of book (edition if it is not the first)*. Publisher.

Department of Planning and Sport. (2018). Capital idea: realising value from social performance. Department of Planning and Sport.

# **Online with Author**

Author's family name, Initial/s. (Year, day month of publication), *Title of webpage*. Webpage publisher. URL

# Online with Corporate Author (company/organisation/government department)

Authoring body. (Year, day month of publication). Title of webpage. Webpage publisher. URL

### Image online

Author/creator, Initial/s. (Year of publication). *Title: subtitle* [type of resource]. Webpage Publisher. URL

Hint: If more than one author, use & between the names

Hint: When the author and publisher name are the same, you do not need to repeat it for the publisher also.

Hint: If resource is from a **book** online, only the year is needed but if it is an **article** online then it will also need the day and month.
